## Dear NJSOM Students & Alumni

I am writing to update you concerning Ministerial Credentials and Internships. If you are planning to pursue *Ministerial Credentials with the Assemblies of God* now or at any time in the future, at either the Certified, Licensed or Ordained level, completing a Ministerial Internship at the appropriate level is mandatory in order to be considered for AG Ministerial Credentials. While it is not mandatory to graduate from the NJ School of Ministry with your Ministerial Studies Diploma, it is mandatory to complete an internship if you are pursuing Ministerial Credentials (Certified, Licensed, or Ordained) with the Assemblies of God.

If you are a **current** NJSOM student **who does NOT possess a current AG Ministerial** Credential, but plan to pursue Ministerial Credentials, please do not wait until you have graduated to begin pursuing a Ministerial Internship, as this will delay your application process for Ministerial Credentials. For instance, if you are pursuing Ministerial Credentials at the Certified level, then, begin working on that level.

On the other hand, **if you already hold AG Ministerial Credentials** at the <u>Certified level</u> and are looking to advance to the <u>Licensed level</u>, you should complete a License Ministerial Internship. If you already possess an AG Ministerial <u>License</u>, you should complete an Ordination Ministerial Internship, so that should you be considered for Ordination, you will have already completed the Ordination Internship.
